Installation:



spigot.

cuff will snap into the

spigot, ensuring that the welded seam of the connector is straight and that points A and B are directly in line.

Your BFM[®] fitting is now ready to go.

It is important when installing or removing the TR fitting to keep your fingers clear of the seal as it snaps into place with force.

CAUTION!

Removal:





Insert the removal tool in the opening of the hole and push towards the center of the fitting.





Hold the seal of the connector and remove from the spigot.

Your spigots are now ready for a new connector.
